2011 Safari Rates, Trophy Fees, & Air Charter Information
Big Game Hunting Safaris

Big game hunting safaris are sold as Safari Packages, with a single client hunting with one Professional Hunter (PH), forming a 1x1 combination and two clients with one Professional Hunter (PH), forming a 2x1 combination etc. We recommend that each client have their own Professional Hunter to improve their chances of success. Tanzania's normal hunting season dates are 1 July to 31 December; however the 2011 hunting season has been extended to March 2012.

Rates shown below are per hunter in US\$ and may differ from actual safari quote, depending on number of clients and miscellaneous options. Trophy fees, air charters, and miscellaneous options are **not included** in rates shown on this page. Please review page 3 for inclusions/exclusions. Archery hunters: prices differ for archery licenses and trophy fees. Please request personalized quotation for bow hunting safaris.

Companion Hunters & Observers

Companion hunts allow two clients to share the game on a 10, 16, 21 or 28 day license normally set aside for one hunting client. Both clients share one Professional Hunter (2x1) and will accompany each other on safari. Both clients have hunting licenses, allowing trophies to be exported separately. Companion hunts are only available during 1x1 or 2x2 combination safaris.

Trophy Fee Deposit Per Hunter

A refundable deposit applicable towards your trophy fees is *required* before your departure to Tanzania. Any additional trophy fees are due to outfitter prior to departure from Tanzania.

Miscellaneous Safari Options & Fees

Firearm Import Fee	\$200 per firearm; includes up to 200 rounds of ammunition for that firearm. Each hunting client may import up to 3 firearms of <i>different calibers</i> ; maximum of 1 shotgun.
Archery/Bow Import Fee	\$75 per bow, unlimited number of arrows.
Camp Rifle & Shotgun Rental	\$200 per gun per week, or \$30 per gun per day. Premium ammunition purchase is additional, approx. \$11 per round rifle & \$2 per shotshell. Available rifle calibers: .300 Win mag, .375 H&H, .416 Rigby. Available shotguns: Beretta over-under in 12 & 20 gauge.
Camp Satellite Phone & Internet/email Use	Each safari camp has a satellite phone and internet modem which is available for client use at a price of approximately \$1.00 per minute (phone) and \$8.00 per Mb sent/rec'd (internet). The final cost of use will be billed to client post-safari.
Additional Baiting Vehicle	\$375 per day for additional vehicle & baiting crew. Cost of bait animals is not included in price.
Additional Safari Vehicle & Guide	\$575 per day for additional vehicle and professional guide.

Air Charter Rates To/From Camps (each way)

Hunts for Lake Natron South & Rungwa Ikili are typically based out of Arusha.

Hunts for the Selous Game Reserve are based out of Dar es Salaam.

All Charters quoted above are for a Cessna 208. Maximum group size is 6(six) people including professional hunters. All departure and arrival times, routing, passengers, cargo and rates for air transfers are determined at the discretion of the charter service and are subject to change without advance notice. For groups less than 3 people a Cessna 206 may be available at lower rates. For groups larger than 8 people it may be necessary to book two charter flights, or a larger plane if available. All safari charters will be quoted on a group by group basis. Road transfer to/from Arusha and Natron area is also available at a rate of \$350 each way.

Exclusive Bird Hunting Safaris (Shotgun or Falconry)

Tanzania offers some of the finest bird hunting available in Africa today. Game birds on license include: sandgrouse, francolin, spurfowl, guinea fowl, doves, ducks, and geese. Several bird hunting options are available during your Big Game Safari.

For the bird-hunting enthusiast, we also offer exclusive wing-shooting or falconry safaris in our Maasailand area, Lake Natron South. A maximum of four clients per Professional Hunter per package is allowed. Bag limits: maximum 50 birds per client, per day but not more than ten of any particular species. Best time for bird hunting is October onwards. For single-person safaris or groups in excess of 6 persons, please request a personalized quotation.

Safari Rates Include

- 7, 10, 16, 21 or 28 days of hunting or observer days in field plus travel days to and from your hunting area.
- *Estimated* Government conservation fees, hunting licenses, concession/block fees, and local taxes. Government rates may be subject to increase. Actual 2011 rates may vary and are applicable to the year-of safari.
- All luxury camp accommodations during the safari, meet/greet at airports and transfers to/from hotels and airports
- Professional Hunter(s) services and trained safari staff services.
- One 4-wheel drive vehicle with each Professional Hunter, equipped with satellite communications, winch, refrigerator, medical bag and a comprehensive set of tools and spares.
- Provision of all camp equipment to the highest standard.
- Finest quality locally available foods, soft drinks and alcoholic beverages.
- Field preparation of trophies (skinning and salting) and transfer to Arusha.
- Dipping, processing, crating, packing, export documentation for trophies and transportation to the airport ready for export
- Comprehensive first-aid kits in each camp and complimentary membership in medical air-evacuation program if client does not already have current program.

Safari Rates Do Not Include

- Actual 2011 Government Game Trophy Fees, Anti-poaching & Conservation fees (see Total Trophy Fee amounts on “Trophy Fees & Species Availability” list above.
- Final Government imposed licenses, trophy fees, area fees, or other. These rates may be subject to change without advance notification, and are also dependent on species and total number of animals shot during the safari.
- * **Elephant Surcharge Fee:** any elephant shot or wounded during a regular priced 21-28 day safari in the Selous must pay an additional surcharge of \$6,500 regardless of trophy size, *plus* associated trophy fee rate per category/size of bull elephant.
- Import permits for firearms or bows, or rental of company firearms and cost of ammunition.
- Miscellaneous items such as additional baiting vehicle and satellite phone/internet use (\$1 per minute phone, \$8 per kb used).
- Import permits for CITES listed animals such as leopard & elephant, and freight charges for trophies and personal belongings from Tanzania to country of final destination.
- Air transport to and from Tanzania and air transfers or private charters within Tanzania (See Air Charter Rates). Charter rates are per plane and subject to change without notice. Each safari client/group will be quoted on individual basis.
- Air charters/transfers or commercial airfare for requested Professional Hunter area change.
- Hotel expenses in Dar es Salaam or Arusha before and after the safari.
- Champagne and specially requested imported food and drink.
- Tanzania Tourist Visas and airport departure taxes.
- Transfer fees from Nairobi to Dar Es Salaam or Arusha, and firearms clearing, meet and greet and ground transfers in Nairobi.
- Gratuities/tips for staff – typically 10-15% of daily rate; preferred form of tip is in US\$ Cash.
- National Park fees where applicable, side-trips outside the hunting areas, or other special requests.

Payment of Fees

- A deposit of 50% of the total daily rate is required to confirm a booking if the safari is within 365 days of commencement. See Terms & Conditions for payment information on booking safaris more than 365 days in advance.
- Full pre-payment for your safari must be received 90 days prior to the start of your safari. If you arrive in Tanzania without having paid in full, you will not be permitted to start your safari.
- Additional trophy fees in excess of any initial deposit are due to Outfitter prior to departure from Tanzania. Cash or wire transfers are preferred. A final invoice from Tanzania Adventures Inc. (TAI) detailing all additional safari and misc expenses, payments to-date and final charges will be provided to the client or booking agent by TAI, within forty-five (45) days of the end of the Client’s safari. Any credit due to client will be refunded at that time.
- Trophies are shipped by outfitter only after full payment for safari or other pre-shipment costs have been received by TAI.
- Daily Outfitting Charges and Government Game & Area Fees are non-refundable. See Terms & Conditions section of the brochure for details.
- All Tanzania Government Fees are subject to change without notice. Any additional taxes, fees, licenses, trophy fees or other charges imposed by the Tanzanian Government are the responsibility of the client.
- Game Trophy Fees actually charged will be those applicable to the year the safari is taken regardless of what is quoted on initial invoices. Invoices and quotes are subject to change based on any change in Government Fees and/or Game Trophy Fees. In the event that you do not collect an animal which you sought while on safari, no trophy fee will apply and any unused deposit paid towards game trophy fees will be applied to the final balance of the Client’s safari, or refunded after the completion of the Client’s safari. Trophy fees - including community development fees - are applicable to all animals bagged or wounded and lost.

Hunting Regulations

The Tanzanian Wildlife Department regulations permit the hunting of both lion and leopard and some East African species only under these combinations:

21 Day Safari License

- 1x1 - 1 lion, 1 leopard, 1 gerenuk, 1 oryx and 1 lesser kudu permit per client.
- 2x1 - Clients must share 1 lion, 1 leopard, 1 gerenuk, 1 oryx and 1 lesser kudu permit.
- 4x2/3x2 - Clients must share 2 lion, 2 leopard, 2 gerenuk, 2 oryx and 2 lesser kudu permits.

LION: company policy restricts lion hunting to males of at least 6 years of age and without young cubs in the pride.

ELEPHANT: Company policy restricts elephants to mature males of at least 45 pounds on one tusk.

Firearm/Archery and Ammunition Import

Each hunting client may import a maximum of **three firearms of different calibers**. We recommend one large caliber, one medium caliber and one shotgun (for bird hunters). The maximum amount of ammunition allowed is 200 rounds per caliber/firearm, but this amount is often greater than the weight allowances of most airlines. We suggest 60 rounds for a heavy rifle and 100 rounds for a medium rifle. *Restrictions Per Tanzanian law* - Automatic weapons and handguns are **PROHIBITED**. The minimum caliber for lion, buffalo, and elephant is .375, and .240 on all other game. Some medium caliber solid ammunition is useful for hunting the smaller antelope species such as dik dik and duiker. **ARCHERY** hunters may import up to three bows and unlimited number of arrows. We recommend bringing at least two bows on safari.

Wildlife Management

The Outfitter, Tanzania Wildlife Company Ltd. (TWC), together with the Tanzania Wildlife Department is responsible for the sustainable off-take of trophy animals. They have an obligation to protect, monitor and manage our wildlife resources and habitat. This responsibility extends to you, the hunter. Quotas are determined annually, and provided all hunt wisely, the quality of trophies can be maintained and in some cases the quality of trophy animals in the hunting blocks can be improved. TWC maintains careful records of every trophy collected and uses this data to manage their annual trophy harvest. Until recently, very little was known about the management of free ranging lion. Researchers have now produced evidence which clearly indicates that very specific males should be harvested. TWC has enforced an existing management strategy that ensures only non-breeding lions are collected. They ask that you adopt this strategy and accept the decision of your professional hunter to either collect or reject the trophy.

Personal Property & Purchases

Tanzania Adventures Inc. and associated outfitters or suppliers are not responsible for your personal belongings. The Outfitter has a safe in Arusha, and we recommend that anything of value be locked in the safe while you are on safari. Any purchases made while en route to, within Tanzania, or while on safari are the sole responsibility and liability of the client. Neither TAI nor the outfitter is responsible for the handling, storage, and shipping to final destination of such purchases or acquisitions, or liable for the recovery or replacement of these items.

Quota

The hunting of trophies is subject to quota availability. We cannot guarantee that you will be able to hunt all your requested trophies in each area allocated for your safari. Tanzania is a country in which hunting concessions and wildlife areas are unfenced and game is free to move throughout the country. As such, we do not offer guarantees that you will collect any given species during your safari. We strive to provide you with a reasonable opportunity to hunt your desired species within our hunting concessions. Your requested quota will be allotted to you at time of booking, and finalized prior to start of safari.
